Tribal Area Sub Plan - Wells Electrification

- ✓ The annual programme decided by State Government & 100% grant provided by state Government for HT/LT lines and Transformer Centres.
- ✓ Any applicant in tribal area can get Agriculture connection under this scheme.
- ✓ Works under the scheme are taken up as per the priority of registration.
- ✓ Scheme for Tribal area Electrification, in which Infrastructure cost is not to be recovered from the applicant.
- ✓ Applicant has to pay only Reg.charge, Security deposit, Test Report Charges & Agreement fee.
- ✓ Energy deposit charges reimbursed to applicant by Project Administrator.
- ✓ Two months are allowed to applicant for preparation of Borewell & Meter room.

Normal Aq. Wells

(Special Project Agriculture -SPA)

- ✓ Scheme for Non-Tribal area & Non Dark Zone area .
- ✓ Works under this scheme are taken up as per the priority of registration maintained at sub division level and as per the annual program decided by Statel Government.
- ✓ The annual program decided by State Government & Discom's arranging fund from their internal resources or debts from financial institution.
- ✓ To clear the backlog of huge pending Agricultural applications, Govt. Provides the financial assistance as share capital for Electrification of AG Wells (Normal & Darkzone)
- ✓ Applicant has to pay only Reg.charge, Security deposit, Slab wise KW base fixed charges as per GERC approval of dated 01.07.2014, Test Report Charges & Agreement fee.
- ✓ Two months are allowed to applicant for preparation of Borewell & Meter room.

Darkzone Ag. Wells

- ✓ Scheme for Dark Zone area . Vadodara Dist. & Kheda Dist. are under Dark Zone area. In Vadodara Dist., Vadodara Taluka & In Kheda Dist., Kathlal, Kapadvanj & Mehmedabad Taluka falls under Dark Zone Area.
- ✓ Earlier, there was a ban on releasing any Agriculture connection in Darkzone area as per GoG GR No. GWR-2003-14-J-1 dtd. 16.12.2003 & 05.08.2004 of Narmada Water Resources & Water Supply Department. It is lifted vide Narmada Water Resources & Water Supply Department GoG GR No. GWR-2013-14-J-1 dtd. 27.03.2012 & EPD Letter No. ELC-2012-773-K-1 dtd. 12.04.2012 with a condition that MIS is mandatory.
- ✓ The applications were registered between dt.17.09.2012 to 16.10.2012 & priority has been fixed by draw in presence of Public as per A,B,C,D Category as instructed by EPD Letter vide: ELC-2012-773-K1 Dtd. 03.09.2012

A Category : Old Registered, getting connection in any other scheme, but original DZ registered application Pending.

B Category : Old Registered application but not getting connection.

C Category : Fresh application having Bore/ Well. (Priority decided by Draw system)

D Category : Fresh application, but No Bore/ Well (Priority decided by Draw system)

- ✓ Works under this scheme are taken up as per the priority of registration-Categorywise i.e. A,B,C, & D maintained at sub division level and as per the annual program decided by State Government.

Darkzone Ag. Wells

- ✓ Applications registered under C-category which are registered as bore/ well existing, if bore/ well does not found exist as per priority arrival & during survey it is shifted to D-Category at the last priority.
- ✓ The annual program decided by State Government & to clear the backlog of huge pending Agricultural applications, Govt. Provides the financial assistance as share capital for Electrification of AG Wells (Normal & Darkzone)
- ✓ Applicant has to pay only Reg.charge, Security deposit, Slab wise KW base fixed charges as per GERC approval of dated 01.07.2014, Test Report Charges & Agreement fee.
- ✓ Three months are allowed to applicant for preparation of Borewell & Meter room.

Tatkal Ag. Wells

- ✓ Implemented in All areas of the MGVCL. Applicant has to pay Rs.500/- as Registration charges for switch over to Tatkal Scheme.
- ✓ Work executed by Overriding normal priority.
- ✓ Tatkal Scheme – 2010 (Cut off date for old Registered applications: 10.09.2010)
 - ▶ 80% cost of the Technical Sanction amount & Security Deposit, Test Report Charges,agreement fee to be recovered from the Applicant and 20% cost to be borne by DISCOMs.
 - ▶ Who adopt drip system, 50% cost of the Technical Sanction amount & Security Deposit, Test Report Charges,agreement fee to be recovered from the Applicant and 50% cost to be borne by DISCOMs.
- ✓ Tatkal Scheme - 2013 (Cut off date for old Registered applications: 31.03.2013)
 - ▶ 80% cost of the Technical Sanction amount & Security Deposit, Test Report Charges,agreement fee to be recovered from the Applicant
 - ▶ Three months time limit notice is issued to applicant for preparation of Borewell & Meter room.
- ✓ Tatkal Scheme – 2015 (Cut off date for old Registered applications: 31.12.2014)
 - 70% cost of the Technical Sanction amount & Security Deposit, Test Report Charges,agreement fee to be recovered from the Applicant
 - Three months are allowed to applicant for preparation of Borewell & Meter room.
 - Work executed on “First come, first serve” basis.

Scheduled Caste AG (SC AG)

- ✓ Any Schedule caste applicant in Tribal area, Non-Tribal area & Dark zone area can get Agriculture connection under this scheme.
- ✓ Works under this scheme are taken up by Overriding normal priority.
- ✓ The Scheme is declared by GoG vide EPD Letter No. BJT/2014/3191/K1 dtd. 09.04.2015.
- ✓ Under DZ area MIS/Sprinkler is mandatory in entire irrigation area of land of demanded LS No. upto 2 Acres & above 2 Acres, 50% of total Land.
- ✓ The annual program decided by State Government. All expenditure against HT/LT Lines and transformer centers booked against grant received from state government.
- ✓ Applicant has to produce Caste Certificate issued by Social Welfare Department.
- ✓ Applicant has to pay only Reg.charge, Security deposit, Test Report Charges & Agreement fee.
- ✓ Two months are allowed to applicant for preparation of Borewell & Meter room.

Lift Irrigation Scheme

- ✓ Scheme for Registered Co-operative Society/ Mandali, Irrigation Dept., SSNNL & GWRDC in Tribal, Non-Tribal & Dark Zone area .
- ✓ Works under this scheme are taken up by Overriding normal priority.
- ✓ As per GUVNL guideline : GUVNL/RE/Sp. Priority/1048 dtd. 06.12.2006, decided in Apex Committee meeting of dtd. 22.11.2006, Overriding priority is allowed to Registered Co-operative Society/ Mandali in Tribal Area & subject to implementation of MIS in non-Tribal area.
- ✓ Registered Co-operative society is allowed only one motor for Lift Irrigation. However, as per GUVNL Guideline : GUVNL/Tech/LI/Sadguru/1965 dtd.26.08.2014 only those Registered Co-operative society are allowed more than one motor under one roof structure only (pump house) for LI Scheme which are supported/ affiliated to N.M. Sadguru Water & Development Foundation, Dahod & if whole expenditure of Electric infrastructure shall be borne by them . Allowed only 8 hrs. power supply through AG DOM feeder & Tatkall Tariff shall be applicable.
- ✓ As per E&P Dept., GoG, Gandhinagar letter : GUV-12-2012-2337-K-1 dtd. 25.02.2013, If whole expenditure of Electric infrastructure shall be borne by SSNNL , should be allowed 24 hrs. power supply from JGY Feeder & more than one motor under one roof structure (pump house), only for Project affected farmers of Narmada yojana without insisting MIS. LTP (Lift Irrigation) & HTP-V tariff shall be applicable.
- ✓ As per GUNVL guideline : GUVNL/Tech/LIS/896 dtd. 08.04.2013, If whole expenditure of Electric infrastructure be borne by Irrigation Dept./SSNNL & GWRDC, more than one motor under one roof structure (pump house) should be allowed. For Irrigation dept.8 hrs. power supply through AG DOM feeder & Tatkall tariff shall be applicable while for SSNNL(For Project Affected Farmers only) & GWRDC, 24 hrs. power supply through JGY Feeder should be applicable & LTP(Lift Irrigation) & HTP-V tariff should be applicable.
- ✓ Individual applicants cannot allowed for Lift Irrigation as per GUVNL Guideline : GUVNL/Tech/CE(T)/SPT/LTP-V/2424 dtd. 30.10.2010 & GUVNL/Tech/RE/DSO/580 dtd. 02.04.2014.

Zupadpatti Scheme

- ▶ Electric connection for house hold is given free of cost for improvement of living Standard of BPL Beneficiaries who resides in Rural as well as Urban areas.
- ▶ Beneficiaries who reside in Gamtal or in cluster of 20 can get connection.
- ▶ BPL beneficiaries having Annual Income below Rs 150000/- under urban area and Rs. 120000/- for rural area.
- ▶ List of beneficiaries will be prepared & approved by Nagar Palika / Municipal Corporation / TDO.
- ▶ Huts built on land of Gram Panchayat / Govt. / Nagar Palika / Municipal Corporation can be covered but beneficiaries will not right to be owner of land.
- ▶ Beneficiaries will also get the connection in Ag. Land if he is owner of the land.
- ▶ 100% grant is provided by State Govt.
- ▶ No any Charges to be paid by applicant .
- ▶ A single point lighting connection complete with wiring & LED bulb is given under this Scheme.
- ▶ Old infrastructure can be upgraded for Robust under System Improvement for Reliability of Power Supply.

Kutir jyoti Scheme

- ▶ Electric connection for house hold is given free of cost for improvement of living Standard of BPL Beneficiaries who resides in Tribal areas.
- ▶ Beneficiaries who reside in Gamtal or in cluster of 10 can get connection.
- ▶ BPL beneficiaries having Annual Income below Rs. 120000/- for rural area.
- ▶ List of beneficiaries will be prepared & approved by Project Administrator.
- ▶ 100% grant is provided by State Govt.
- ▶ No any Charges to be paid by applicant .
- ▶ A single point lighting connection complete with wiring & LED bulb is given under this Scheme.
- ▶ Old infrastructure can be upgraded for Robust under System Improvement for Reliability of Power Supply.

TASP Peta para Scheme

- ▶ Electric connection for house hold is given free of cost for improvement of living Standard of BPL Beneficiaries who resides in Tribal areas.
- ▶ Beneficiaries who reside in Gamtal or in cluster of 10 can get connection.
- ▶ BPL beneficiaries having Annual Income below Rs. 120000/- for rural area.
- ▶ List of beneficiaries will be prepared & approved by Project Administrator.
- ▶ 100% grant is provided by State Govt.
- ▶ No any Charges to be paid by applicant .
- ▶ A single point lighting connection complete with wiring & LED bulb is given under this Scheme.
- ▶ Old infrastructure can be upgraded for Robust under System Improvement for Reliability of Power Supply.

SCSP (Scheduled Caste Sub Plan) Scheme

- ▶ Electric connection for house hold is given free of cost for improvement of living Standard of Scheduled Caste Beneficiaries who resides in Urban & Rural area
- ▶ Applicable to Schedule Caste beneficiaries residing in Urban & Rural area without income limit.
- ▶ The certificate of caste issued by Social Welfare Department must be enclosed with the application.
- ▶ Indira Awas, Indira Nagar, Sardar awas, 100 Sq. Yard Mafat plot or similar new vasahat were the population of Schedule caste is 40% or more than the total population can be covered.
- ▶ For infrastructure development minimum 20 applicants & amongst 40% of SC Beneficiaries are required.
- ▶ 100% grant is provided by State Govt.
- ▶ No any Charges to be paid by applicant .
- ▶ A single point lighting connection complete with wiring & LED bulb is given under this Scheme.
