



PUBLIC NOTICE

Appeal to Public for Voluntarily Disclosure of their actual connected load.

It has come to the notice that in many cases, the actual connected load at consumers' installation is more than contracted demand. The consumers add from time to time various gadgets/appliances such as Geyser, Washing Machine, House Flour Mill, Air Coolers/Air Conditioners, Big screen TV, Home Theatre, Computers, etc. without informing and regularizing the load with MG VCL. Due to this unexpected increase in load, electrical net work gets overloaded resulting into voltage fluctuation, low voltage complaints, blowing of fuses and circuit fuses, burning of transformers, etc. Further more, the existing metering system will also be inadequate to register exact consumption due to additional load, which is unauthorized use of power and hence financial irregularity. This unexpected load will also result into inferior quality of power supply to other genuine consumers of the surrounding area.

In view of above, MG VCL has formulated a "Voluntary Disclosure Scheme" for all Residential, Commercial (only NRG P) and agricultural consumers. All the esteemed consumers are requested to contact the local Sub-Division office and voluntarily declare the actual load connected at their installation within a fortnight from the date of publishing of this Notice. The broad terms & conditions of Voluntary Disclosure Scheme are as under:

- 1) Consumers shall pay Security Deposit for additional load only as per prevailing rates.
- 2) To cater to additional load declared, consumers shall pay KW based fixed charges as per GERC norms, instead of actual cost of line and transformer charges as in case of normal additional load request i.e. instead of recovering actual line charges and transformer charges, only KW based fixed charges will be recovered from the consumers coming forward in this scheme as a one time exercise.

On expiry of stipulated time, in case of those consumers who have not come forward under this VDS, MG VCL will calculate the contract demand based on average consumption and accordingly revise the present contract demand & recover necessary charges for regularizing the same. MG VCL will also carry out intensive installation checking and if consumers are found using more load than contract load, then necessary line charges, transformer charges, security deposit will be recovered and further actions as per Indian Electricity Act 2003 will be initiated.

MG VCL requests all the consumers to take full advantage of above Scheme by declaring their additional load to their Sub-Division Office instantly.
